Problem Wk.7.1.2: Look up an entry in an alist.

Now, you should implement the procedure lookup(al, k), where al is an association list and k is a key.

If there is an entry with key k it should return **the two-element list containing the key and the value**, otherwise it should return None. (Remember that the Python shell doesn't print None when it is the result of evaluating an expression, so don't be surprised if you try a failed lookup and no result gets printed out.)
