Listen to *Ba Ban* and *November Steps* (< 30 minutes total). As you listen, take brief notes (with enough detail to jog your memory in discussion) on the sounds you hear that have "non-Western" connotations, on the aspects of the piece that seem more "conventionally" Western or classical, and on features of the piece that seem to overlap with both terms of the binary – in clichéd terms, "where East meets West."
