- 1. What is the topic?
- 2. What is the main claim main message?
- 3. What are the assertions that support and further the main message?
- 4. Is there evidence to support the assertions?

Ethos -- Credibility – Why should we listen to this author?

- 5. Is the author well informed? How do you know?
- 6. Does the piece offer different sides of the argument? (counterarguments?

Does the author tell how s/he is connected to the issue?

Passion – Why should we care? What is the significance?

- 7. What is the tone like? Engaging? Defensive? In other words, do you feel like you are talking to someone or do you feel like someone is talking at you?
- 8. Does the author say how the issues affect him/her?
- 9. Does the author help you feel connected to the issue?
